



SAKS CHARITY FASHION SHOW

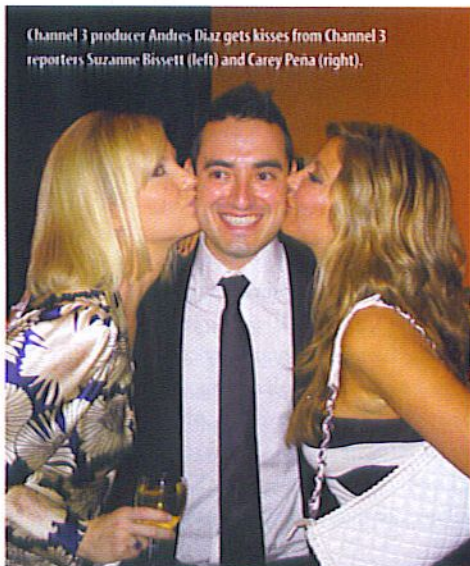

A SWANKY SILVERLEAF FUNDRAISER

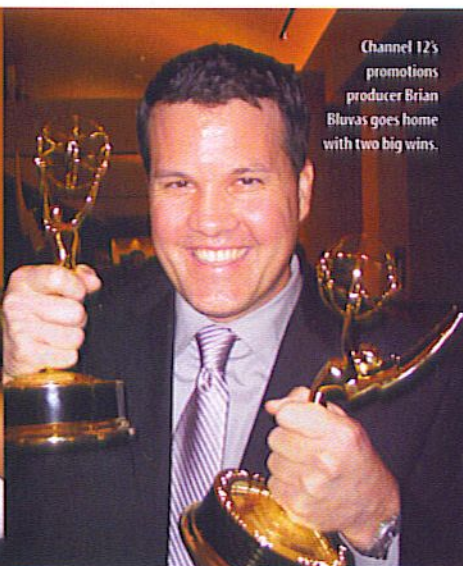
